



# Uniform Policy

## Policy Guidelines

- All students wear the adopted school uniform from the first day of school until the last day of school. Noted exceptions will be, Halloween parties, Christmas program, and as otherwise designated.
- Students are expected to be neat and clean at all times, and they are expected to dress in a manner that indicates that they are involved in serious learning.
- Children attending the After-School Day Care program may change from uniforms to “play clothes.”
- The principal reserves the right to make any final decisions regarding adherence to the uniform policy.
- If a child has special needs regarding the uniform, or requests to be out of uniform for some excusable reason, please contact the principal.

## Boys Uniform

- Pants/Shorts – Boys are allowed to wear pleated front navy pants or pleated front navy shorts.
- Shirts – Boys are required to purchase a red polo shirt with the school emblem. Additional red or white polo shirts may be purchased with the option of the school emblem. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times.
- Sweatshirt/Sweater – Boys have the option of wearing a heather gray, red, or navy sweatshirt and/or a navy cardigan sweater. A red or white polo, or white turtleneck must be worn under the heather gray, red, or navy sweatshirt and navy cardigan sweater. Each sweatshirt and sweater must have the school emblem on it.
- Turtleneck/Undershirts – A traditional white turtleneck maybe worn under the long sleeve polo shirts, the sweatshirt, and the cardigan sweater. A plain white undershirt may be worn, but only as an undergarment to regular uniform attire.

## Girls Uniform

- Pants/Shorts/Skorts – Girls are allowed to wear pleated or flat front navy pants, navy shorts, or navy skorts.
- Shirts – Girls are required to purchase a red polo shirt with the school emblem. Additional red or white polo shirts may be purchased with the option of the school emblem. Shirts are to be tucked in at all times.
- Jumper – Girls may choose to wear the school-appointed jumper. They may wear a three quarter length white stretch blouse, a red or white polo, or a white traditional turtleneck under the jumper.
- Blouse – The three quarter length white stretch blouse is to be worn with the jumper only. It is not to be worn with the pants or shorts.
- Sweater/Sweatshirt – Girls have the option of wearing a heather gray, red, or navy sweatshirt and/or navy cardigan sweater. Each sweatshirt and sweater must have the school emblem on it. A red or white polo shirt, a three quarter length white stretch blouse, or a white turtleneck must be worn under the heather gray, red, or navy sweatshirt and the navy cardigan sweater. The sweatshirt and cardigan may be worn over the jumper.
- Turtleneck– A white turtleneck may also be worn under the long sleeve polo shirts, the sweatshirt, and the navy cardigan sweater.

## Accessories

- School Emblem – The Sacred Heart School emblem is required on any cardigans or sweatshirts, and one red polo shirt. You may order the school emblem on all polo shirts if you desire.
- Belts – Belts worn with pants and shorts will be optional for kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade. Belts must be worn with pants and shorts for grades 2<sup>nd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>. Belts should be navy, black, or brown “dress” belts.
- Socks/Tights – Socks must be worn at all times. They should cover the ankle and have enough elastic to keep them above the ankle. No logos/emblems allowed. All socks should be white, black, or navy in color. Girls have the option of wearing white, black or navy tights under their uniform jumper.

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- Shoes – Shoes should be low-cut or medium-cut: loafers, tennis shoes, low-cut hiking boots are all acceptable. Sandals, open-toed or open heeled shoes may not be worn. Leisure shoes, such as “CROCS” are not considered a part of the uniform shoe policy.
- Hair – Girls hair should be neatly groomed. Hair bows should be simple and not distracting; they should be of uniform-coordinating colors. Boys’ hair should be neatly trimmed and kept from hanging below the eyebrow. The length should be no longer than the top of a dress-shirt collar. Appropriateness of other hairstyles will be upon the discretion of the principal.
- Jewelry – Necklaces: religious crosses, religious medals and small neckline chains with or without a pendant will be accepted. Watches may be worn. Earrings: girls may wear small, modest earrings. Earrings on boys are not permitted.
- Make-up – Make up will not be permitted.
